

**LEGAL NOTICE****CHARLES A. BEARD MEMORIAL SCHOOL CORPORATION  
NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned will receive sealed bids in the Office of the Superintendent of Schools at the Central Office Building located at 8139 W. U.S. Hwy. 40, Knightstown, Indiana, until 10 a.m. on Wednesday, December 21, 2011, on the following fuel items under the following terms, for January 1, 2012, through June 30, 2012. Bids will be decided at the next regular meeting of the School Board of Trustees, at the Media Center in Knightstown High School located at 8149 W. U.S. Hwy. 40.

Item No. 1: 45,000 gallons, more or less, of unleaded regular gasoline with an octane rating of at least 87.

Item No. 2: 20,000 gallons, more or less, of 10 biodiesel fuel with minimum guaranteed cetane rating (number ) of 50 and a maximum guaranteed sulfur rating of 15 ppm.

Item No. 2a: 20,000 gallons, more or less, of ultra low sulfur diesel with minimum guaranteed cetane rating (number) of 50 and a maximum guaranteed sulfur rating of 15 ppm.

Bids will be considered in the following formats:

1. Base price, subject to standard escalation or de-escalation of bidder's wholesale cost, calculated from the base date of December 2, 2011;
2. Fixed price amount per gallon for term of January 1, 2012, through June 30, 2012;
3. Maximum price amount per gallon for term of January 1, 2012, through June 30, 2012.

Bidder may submit a bid in any or all formats.

Note: During winter months, any diesel fuel provided between November 15 and March 15 should be blended with #1 diesel or kerosene at 20 % of total. Alternate treatment, with documentation, will be considered.

Note: This fuel shall be provided at a pumping station providing full access to school buses, with State and Federal approval, within a four (4.0) mile radius of the Office of the Superintendent, located at 8139 W. U.S. Hwy. 40, Knightstown, Indiana, OR fuel may be delivered to the Corporation and IDEM approved sites within the School Corporation if the vendor provides, at no additional cost to the School Corporation, above ground tanks in full compliance with County, State and Federal regulations.

Documentation of octane, cetane and sulfur ratings must be attached to the bid.

Documentation of the process for winter treatments of diesel fuel must be attached to the bid.

The board reserves the right to consider said bids after bid date and reject any or all bids.
